Message from the Founder

As I reflect on Mandla's Foundation's 2020 journey, I am filled with gratitude and pride. Despite the challenges posed by the global pandemic, our commitment to alleviating suffering in our community remained unwavering.

In 2020, we continued to support vulnerable populations through various initiatives, including:

- Flood Relief efforts, which accounted for 43.44% of our expenses:

- Total income: \$2,516;
- Expenses: \$2,531 (98.5% allocated to programs);
- Unrestricted Net Assets: \$2,075;

We look forward to exploring opportunities to partner with local food banks in the future


